We are committed to helping children understand and apply the timeless truths of God's Word. As we work together, we can help our children love and observe the Word of God. - participate in pronouncing all names of the New Testament books.
- be able to retell the Christmas and Easter stories.
- memorize 1 John 4:19, Psalm 118:1, and Psalm 33:4.
 - 1 John 4:19 - "We love because he first loved us."
 - Psalm 118:1 - "Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever."
 - Psalm 33:4 - "For the word of the LORD is right and true; he is faithful in all he does."
